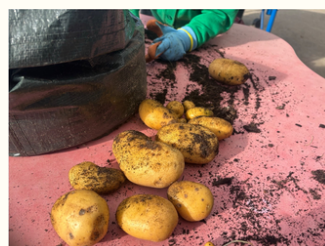
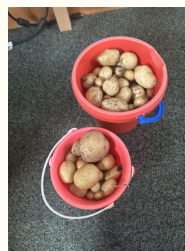
Thema : Llwybrau

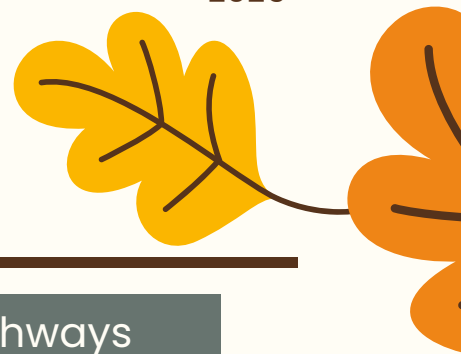
Tyfu Tatws!
